### T-1 River Cruise & Hama-rikyu Gardens

Half-hour boat cruise down the Sumida River travels under some 14 bridges spanning Tokyo's main river, showing the capital's famous landmarks along the way. The cruise will arrive at the majestic Hama-rikyu Gardens, located along the Tokyo Waterfront. Visitors can enjoy a walk in the beautifully preserved garden which the family of the ruling Tokugawa Shogun owned from 17th to mid-19th century, and used to go hunting with falcons.



### T-2 Tokyo Night Tour

Enjoy the night view of Tokyo, driving through Tokyo Tower, Roppongi, Rainbow Bridge, Tsukiji, Ginza, Hibiya and Marunouchi by drive through. (Dinner Exclude)



### T-3 Meiji Jingu Shrine & Harajuku Shopping

The Meiji Jingu Shrine is a Shinto shrine dedicated to Emperor Meiji and his wife Empress Shoken in 1920. You can enjoy shopping at Oriental Bazaar which is a souvenir shop in Harajuku.
